STIPULATED COMPLIANCE AGREEMENT  
YS-25-0001

This Stipulated Compliance Agreement (hereinafter, the "AGREEMENT") is entered into between Ship8 Inc. (hereinafter, "COMPANY") and the Yolo-Solano Air Quality Management District (hereinafter, the "DISTRICT"), (the COMPANY and DISTRICT are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "PARTIES").

RECITALS

- A. The DISTRICT is a political subdivision of the State of California formed in 1971 by a joint powers agreement between Yolo County and Solano County to exercise responsibility for comprehensive air pollution control within all of Yolo County and the northeast portion of Solano County, with its headquarters located at 1947 Galileo Court, Suite 103, Davis, California 95618.
- B. The COMPANY is a shipping and logistics provider that operates a facility at 2222 E. Beamer Street; Woodland, California (hereinafter, "FACILITY"), within the DISTRICT'S jurisdiction and subject to the DISTRICT'S rules and regulations.
- C. The DISTRICT has adopted regulations governing the installation and operation of Internal Combustion (IC) engines rated at 50 horsepower or greater at Stationary Sources. The DISTRICT has also adopted regulations that provide for the issuance of District permits, for New Source Review, and the implementation of Best Available Control Technology (BACT) and Best Available Control Technology for Toxics (T-BACT).
- D. Operation of unpermitted stationary diesel IC engines greater than 50 hp within the DISTRICT violates the regulations adopted by the DISTRICT, and may violate the California Air Resources Board's (CARB's) "Airborne Toxic Control Measure for Diesel Particulate Matter from Stationary Engines Rated at 50 Horsepower and Greater" (hereafter, "ATCM"). Consequently, the owner/operator of such an unpermitted stationary IC engine is liable for penalties under California Health and Safety Code Section 42402 et seq. on each day that the equipment is operated within the DISTRICT.
- E. Background:
  - 1. On October 31, 2002, the Hewlett-Packard Co. was issued Authority to Construct (ATC) C-02-236; and subsequently on December 20, 2002, was issued Permit to Operate (PTO) P-128-02, for operation of an Internal combustion (IC) engine (hereinafter, "ENGINE") powering an emergency fire pump (305 BHP diesel fired Detroit Diesel Corp. IC engine, Model No. DDFP-L6FA8343, Serial No. 6VF-216890). The ENGINE was permitted with the District from 2002 until August 23, 2012, when the permit was cancelled.
  - 2. On April 2, 2024, DISTRICT personnel inspected the ENGINE and determined that the COMPANY had been operating the ENGINE since about 2014, but had failed to obtain a permit as required by DISTRICT rule 3.1. As a result, the DISTRICT mailed Notice of Violation (NOV) #002789 to the COMPANY on May 14, 2024, for violation of DISTRICT Rule 3.1 Section 301.1, and encouraged the COMPANY to return to compliance at the earliest opportunity.
  - 3. The California Health and Safety Code and DISTRICT Rules have provisions for the issuance of permits, and for the transfer of ownership only, or change in operator only, of any article, machine, equipment, or contrivance which previously had a valid permit to operate.
  - 4. The COMPANY attempted to return to compliance on October 17, 2024, by submitting ATC application C-24-179 to the District, to permit the existing ENGINE.
  - 5. The COMPANY is not able to obtain a DISTRICT ATC or PTO for the ENGINE because the ENGINE is not compliant with the requirements of District Rule 3.4, and does not meet Best Available Control Technology (BACT).

6. The COMPANY is required to maintain a fire pump at the FACILITY by the City of Woodland – Fire Department, and sourcing, permitting, and installing a fire pump engine replacement that the DISTRICT can permit may take many months.
  7. Immediate cessation of use of the ENGINE by the COMPANY would be a hardship to a lawful business, and the COMPANY has a need to operate the ENGINE for up to one year (March 1, 2026) without a permit from the DISTRICT.
- F. The PARTIES enter into this AGREEMENT with the intention of fully and finally resolving any civil claim for penalties authorized by California Health and Safety Code Sections 42402 et seq. on each day that the equipment is operated within the DISTRICT for violations of DISTRICT Rules and Regulations, and State and Federal air pollution control laws, on the terms and conditions set forth herein.

AGREEMENT

1. The DISTRICT and COMPANY are resolving any alleged violations addressed herein through this AGREEMENT and acknowledge that this AGREEMENT is not an admission of wrongdoing or negligence.
2. The DISTRICT is the Agency responsible for executing, administering, and enforcing this AGREEMENT.
3. COMPANY agrees that it will do the following:
  - A. Pay an initial stipulated monetary settlement of **\$8,700.00** to the DISTRICT within 15 calendar days of execution of this AGREEMENT.
  - B. Except for the emergency pumping of water in the event of a fire at the FACILITY, the COMPANY will not operate the ENGINE for maintenance and testing purposes, more than the number of hours necessary to comply with the testing requirements of the NFPA 25, or 50 hours, whichever occurs first, during the term of the AGREEMENT.
  - C. Each month, submit to the DISTRICT a daily log of ENGINE operation for the previous month that details the date, start and stop time, the purpose of operation, and hours of operation.
  - D. During the course of the agreement, COMPANY will maintain the ENGINE in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations.
  - E. The COMPANY shall not discharge into the atmosphere any air contaminant for a period or periods aggregating more than 3 minutes in any one hour which is as dark or darker in shade than No. 1 on the Ringelmann Chart; or equal to or greater than 20% opacity.
  - F. The COMPANY shall not discharge from any source whatsoever such quantities of air contaminants or other material which cause injury, detriment, nuisance, or annoyance to any considerable number of persons or to the public or which endanger the comfort, repose, health, or safety of any such persons or the public or which cause to have a natural tendency to cause injury or damage to business or property.
  - G. No later than June 30, 2025, FACILITY will provide to the DISTRICT a proposed plan of action(s), with dated milestones, for the permanent removal of the ENGINE and the acquisition, permitting, and installation of any replacement engine. If a replacement engine is proposed, a complete ATC application shall be submitted to the DISTRICT no later than October 1, 2025.
  - H. This AGREEMENT shall be valid only from March 5, 2025 until March 1, 2026, or until FACILITY finds an alternate means of compliance, whichever occurs first.

4. Provided that COMPANY complies with terms of this AGREEMENT, the DISTRICT agrees that no enforcement action will be taken and no further mitigation or penalties will be sought, other than what is already included in this AGREEMENT, for installation and operation of the unpermitted ENGINE during the term of this AGREEMENT.
5. DISTRICT may take enforcement action (including assessing penalties) against COMPANY if the COMPANY fails to meet any of the terms or conditions of this AGREEMENT.
6. The COMPANY'S failure to meet the terms and conditions of this AGREEMENT may be cause for revocation or termination of this AGREEMENT by the DISTRICT. In the event such failure occurs, the DISTRICT will provide a 10-day written notice of its intent to revoke or terminate this AGREEMENT to the address below. Upon the revocation or termination of this AGREEMENT, operating in a manner except that as allowed by a valid Authority to Construct (ATC) or PTO is subject to enforcement action by DISTRICT.
7. If similar incidents occur in the future, the District will consider the alleged violation(s) a factor in determining future penalties. Furthermore, evidence regarding this violation may be presented in any judicial or variance proceeding by the District where it is deemed pertinent.
10. The person executing this AGREEMENT on behalf of the COMPANY affirmatively represents that he or she has the requisite legal authority to enter into the AGREEMENT on behalf of FACILITY and to bind FACILITY to the terms and conditions of this AGREEMENT. Both the person executing this AGREEMENT on behalf of the COMPANY and FACILITY understands that the DISTRICT is relying on this representation in entering into this AGREEMENT.

Hi Alex,

Thanks for getting back to me. To answer your excellent question, the Stipulated compliance agreement was designed to allow Ship8 to have agreed upon enforcement for conditional operation of the existing fire pump engine without a District permit for the period of the agreement. The agreement does not exempt Ship8 from the requirement to comply with other applicable District rules such as Rule 2.3 – Ringelmann (20% opacity) or Rule 2.5 – Nuisance, although I don't expect that this would be an issue. The agreement also doesn't cover any equipment other than the existing engine.

I reviewed the agreement again and can see that is not necessarily clear. If you are amenable, I can tune up Agreement Item #4 to be more specific that relief is for failing to have a District permit and meet BACT requirements. Alternatively, I can add the opacity and nuisance prohibitions to Agreement Item #3. I am leaning towards this alternative. FYI the 20% opacity limit and the admonition not to be a public nuisance are standard conditions of every District permit.

I'll add in a G and H tomorrow and then send a PDF for signature. Let me know if that is an issue.

I heard back from counsel and she agreed that granting the permit would violate State and District rules and a hearing panel could not grant a permit that violates the rules. Additionally, the burden would be on the applicant appealing a permit denial, Ship8, to prove that the District violated the rules in not issuing the permit. I don't think that your company would be able to make this argument, but any appeal is the decision of Ship8.

I will go ahead and draft a Stipulated Compliance Agreement for you review next week, and I believe that we can live with 1 year to allow time for a permissible engine. I will condition the draft Stip as we discussed.
